Fortunately, the McKinney-Vento Act covers these concerns. Each district in Spartanburg has a McKinney-Vento homeless liaison that ensures that children experiencing homelessness are able to attend their school of origin, have transportation to/from school, and have the things they need for school.

However, they cannot do it without the help of the community. While you are shopping for those last minute school supplies, pick up a few extra if you are able to. Donate these to your local school district to ensure every child has what they need for a successful school year!



McKinney-Vento Act

"The McKinney-Vento Program is designed to address the problems that homeless children and youth face in enrolling, attending, and succeeding in school. Under this program, the SCDE must ensure that each homeless child and youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including a public preschool education, as other children and youth" (South Carolina Department of Education, 2019).
